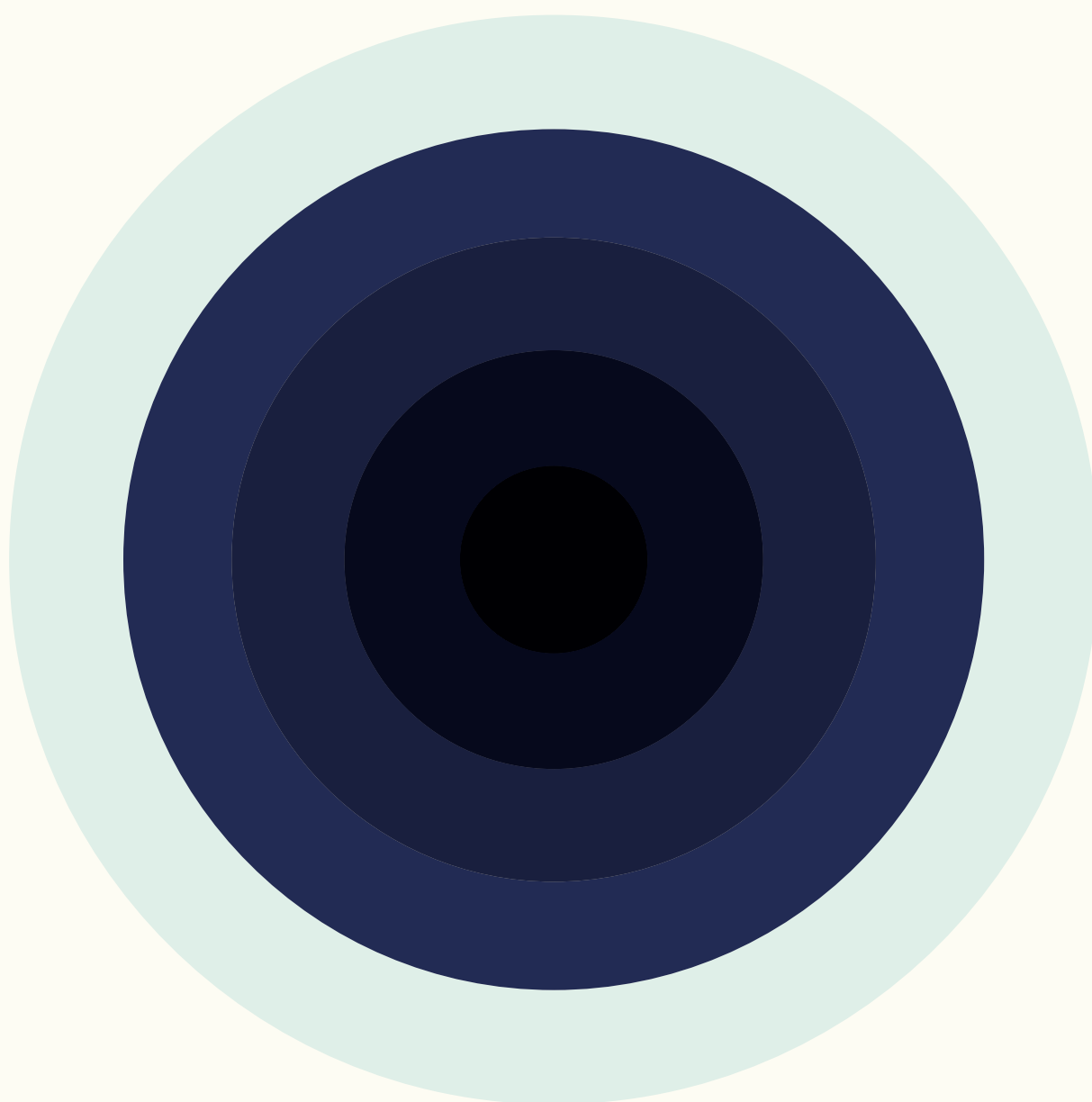

The table reflects grantmaking meeting search criteria for violence against women intended to benefit populations in Europe, as defined by membership in the Council of Europe. For the purposes of this analysis, definitions of Western Europe and Eastern Europe are consistent with those used for Advancing Human Rights, a joint initiative with Foundation Center and IHRFG -- with the exception of Turkey, which is included here as part of Eastern Europe. Where grants specified a geographic area of focus for both Eastern and Western Europe, the full total of the grant is reflected in each category. Where indicated that the grant was intended to benefit the continent as a whole, full amounts are included under the column for overall dollars, only. Grants may be coded for multiple strategies, in which case the full value will be reflected in all applicable categories.
